

SAFEblood MISSION STATEMENT

SafeBlood International is a human rights organisation organized as a private membership association, with the main purpose of re-establishing health freedom, everywhere in the world. It is a human right that every human being has the right to decide for themselves what substances they put into their body. This applies, among other things, to food and medicines. In light of current events, Safeblood is focusing on the right to choose one's own blood donor. Since the beginning of the so-called Covid pandemic in 2001, this has unfortunately no longer been possible in many places, and we are committed to re-establishing this fundamental right.

Why is this urgently needed? With the advent of the first mRNA injections (initially mainly the Covid-19 'vaccinations'), it has unfortunately been confirmed that their residues are also passed on 1:1 via blood transfusions, and parts of them also via other transmission routes. Firstly, this clearly violates the free choice to decide for or against vaccination, and secondly, in many cases it poses significant health risks, including death. The many case studies can no longer be ignored.

We want to ensure an mRNA residue-free blood supply in each of the more than 60 countries in which we currently operate. To achieve this, we focus on 7 main purposes, namely:

- 1) Restoring the free choice of the blood donor, re-introduce directed and autologous donations
- 2) To provide information about possible alternatives to blood transfusion
- 3) To establish a worldwide network of donors/recipients of mRNA-unvaccinated members
- 4) To put pressure on authorities to introduce labelling of mRNA-residues in blood donations
- 5) To offer solutions and therapies for already "vaccinated" people and victims transmission
- 6) To spread information about the risks of mRNA- 'vaccinations'
- 7) To procure blood from blood donors who have not been vaccinated with mRNA.

Safeblood International, together with medical partners, also aims to create the necessary infrastructure and logistics (database and eventually blood bank) for this purpose.
